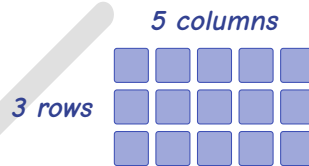

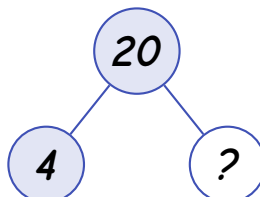

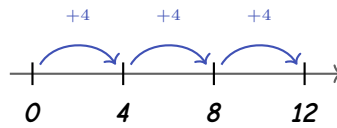

Chapter 1

Quiz 1: Place Value: Ones, Tens, Hundreds

Explanations

1 Count: 3 hundreds (300) + 4 tens (40) + 7 ones (7) = 347.

2 In 582, the digit 8 is in the tens place. Its value is $8 \times 10 = 80$. Don't confuse the digit (8) with its value (80).

3 Add the values: $600 + 30 + 9 = 639$. The hundreds digit is 6, the tens digit is 3, and the ones digit is 9.

4 Break apart each digit: 4 hundreds = 400, 7 tens = 70, 5 ones = 5. So $475 = 400 + 70 + 5$.



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5 Compare hundreds first: both have 4 hundreds. Compare tens: 8 tens $>$ 2 tens. So $482 > 428$.

6 The blocks show 2 hundreds, 5 tens, and 3 ones = 253, not 250. Count the ones carefully — there are 3, not 0.

7 Break each number into hundreds, tens, and ones. 273: 2 hundreds + 7 tens + 3 ones. 546: 5 hundreds + 4 tens + 6 ones. 189: 1 hundred + 8 tens + 9 ones.

8 Ones digit = 2 (Clue 3). Tens digit = 0 (Clue 2). Hundreds digit = $2 + 3 = 5$ (Clue 1). The number is 502.

Chapter 2

Explanations

1 There are 4 groups with 3 stars in each group. Groups $\times$ items in each group = $4 \times 3 = 12$.

2 The array has 3 rows and 5 columns. Rows $\times$ columns = $3 \times 5 = 15$.

3 $4 \times ? = 20$. Since $4 \times 5 = 20$, the missing number is 5.



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- 4 Each jump is $+4$. Count 3 jumps: $0 \rightarrow 4 \rightarrow 8 \rightarrow 12$. So $3 \times 4 = 12$.
- 5 Left: 2 groups of $6 = 12$ dots. Right: 3 groups of $3 = 9$ dots. $12 > 9$, so the left side has more.
- 6 5 fishbowls each with 3 fish: $5 \times 3 = 15$ fish in all.
- 7 The array has 2 rows and 4 columns. We can read it as $2 \times 4 = 8$ or $4 \times 2 = 8$. Both equal 8 because multiplication can be done in any order (commutative property).
- 8 Any two different arrays where rows $\times$ columns $= 24$. Examples: 3 rows of 8, or 4 rows of 6. Each must total 24 stickers.
