Key Math Words

- **Factor** — a number you multiply
- **Product** — multiply answer
- **Quotient** — divide answer
- **Remainder** — leftover after dividing
- **Sum** — add answer
- **Difference** — subtract answer
- **Numerator** — top of a fraction
- **Denominator** — bottom of a fraction
- **Equivalent** — equal in value
- **Decimal** — number with a decimal point
- **Prime** — only divisible by 1 and itself
- **Composite** — has more than 2 factors
- **Perimeter** — distance around a shape
- **Area** — space inside a shape
- **Symmetry** — same on both sides of a line
- **Degree** — unit for angles (°)



The Alligator Trick: The alligator's mouth always opens toward the bigger number. So $5 > 3$ means the mouth opens toward 5 (the bigger one).

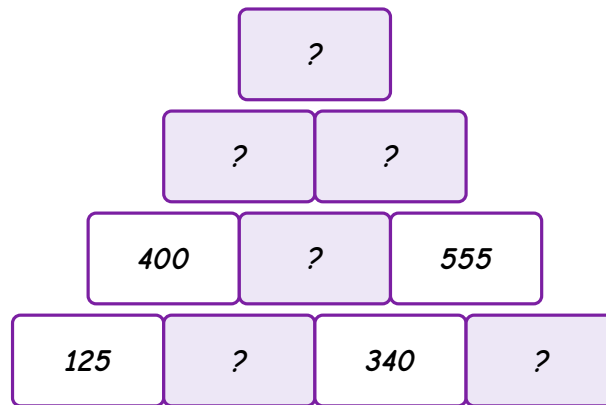
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Addition Pyramid
