- **Angle** — formed by two rays
- **Degree** (°) — unit for angles
- **Perimeter** — distance around a shape
- **Area** — space inside a shape
- **Parallel** — lines that never meet
- **Perpendicular** — lines meeting at 90°

Perimeter of a Rectangle $P = 2 \times (\text{length} + \text{width})$

Area of a Rectangle $A = \text{length} \times \text{width}$

Equivalent Fractions $\frac{a}{b} = \frac{a \times n}{b \times n}$

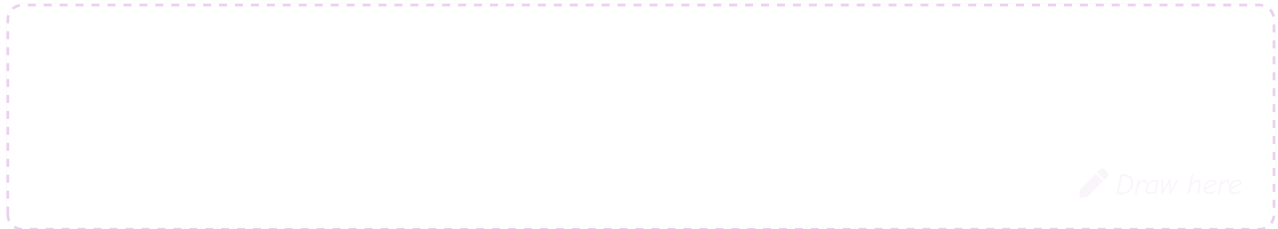

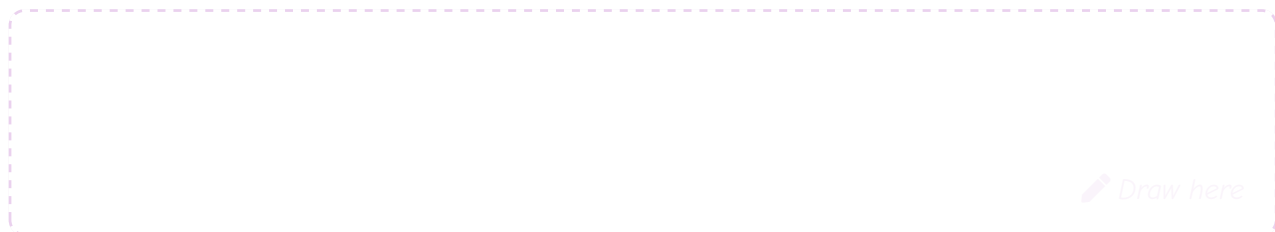
